The Arts Education Partnership is seeking submissions of art to be featured as the cover design for the program of the AEP Fall National Forum, "Charting a Course for the Arts and 21st Century Learning" to be held in October 2-3, 2009 in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

AEP Forums are national meetings which serve as the major convening point to address important issues, themes, and trends affecting arts education and to share information and resources among national, state and local constituencies. Attendees are leaders in the field of arts education, including researchers, practitioners, and government representatives at the national, state and local level. For the theme of the Fall National Forum in Massachusetts, we are focusing on the ways the principles of 21st century learning, particularly imagination, creativity and innovation, are incorporated, articulated and supported throughout the education system from pre-K to higher education.

Submission Guidelines

All applicants must be between the ages of 13-25 and reside and/or be a student in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Submissions must

- Include the attached informational form
- Be related to or inspired by the AEP Forum theme: "Charting a Course for the Arts and 21st Century Learning"
- Be a visual display in a two-dimensional format which can be translated to become the cover of a printed program (drawing, graphic design, photography, mixed media, etc.)
