2022–23 State of the Arts Report

Ingenuity's 2022–23 State of the Arts report shows clear trends of recovery since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. However, there are disparities in arts access by school governance structure (district-managed, charter, contract, etc.) and by student demographics. Additional metrics that continue to challenge progress include instructional minutes in elementary schools and the breadth and depth of disciplines offered in high schools.

Poetry Out Loud National Finals

The **2024 Poetry Out Loud National Finals** will be held May 1–2 in Washington, D.C. This event brings together high school students from across the nation to the capital for an exciting poetry recitation competition. All 55 state and jurisdictional champions will compete in the national semifinals on Wednesday, May 1. Nine finalists will then proceed to the finals on Thursday, May 2.
