### New Partnership to Use Data to Address Student Access to Arts Education

Through this three-year partnership, Ingenuity and the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts will **implement the artlook® data platform in six cities** — designated as Ensuring the Arts for Any Given Child sites across the nation. The platform will provide cities with data about access to arts learning in their schools and enable the partnership to broadly explore access in public schools to help improve equitable learning opportunities for students.

#### **Grants Available to Support Small Museums**

The Institute of Museum and Library Services is accepting applications for its **Inspire! Grants for Small Museums initiative**, which provides funding for projects that address priorities in the grantee's strategic mission. Funded projects must align with one of three categories identified by IMLS, with supporting activities that could include engaging students in museum education, developing school curricula and providing professional development for educators. **Deadline to Apply: Nov. 15.** 

#### League of American Orchestras Accepting

This program provides member orchestras with annual grants of up to \$25,000 to support work that **advances knowledge and understanding of equity**, **diversity and inclusion issues** and the creation of EDI strategies for their respective communities. Grantees can use the funds for a range of activities, including creating group- or peer-based learning groups, conducting an institutional audit and professional development opportunities. **Deadline to Apply: Dec. 6.**

The training from NASA provided eighth-grade students with **hands-on experience in robotics** and opportunities to develop skills across the different disciplines of STEAM education.
