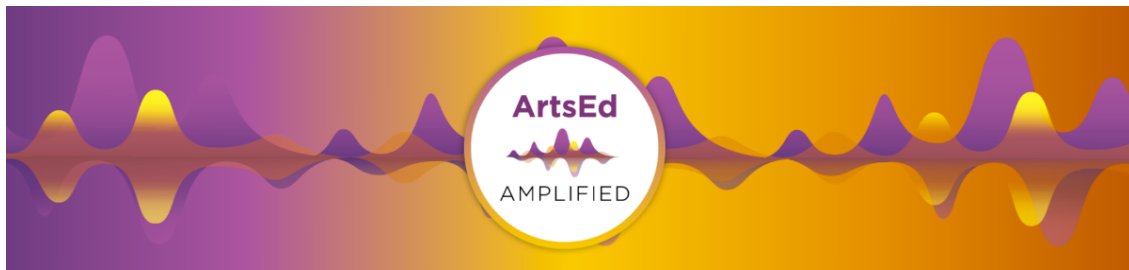
California Approves Proposition 28

The last issue of ArtsEd Digest included a story about California's **Proposition 28**, a ballot measure that would require the state to provide the equivalent of 1% of California's state funding for public schools from pre-kindergarten through 12th grade for the arts. In a major support of arts education, **California voters approved** the measure by 75.8%.

AL Adds New High School Graduation Requirement for Class of 2028
